The following rubric explains what I will be looking for as I read and grade your assignments

Category	For an A:	For a B:	For a C:
Grammar and Spelling	Writer makes no errors in grammar or spelling that distract the reader from the content.	Writer makes 1-2 errors in grammar or spelling that distract the reader from the content.	Writer makes more than 4 errors in grammar or spelling that distract the reader from the content.
Penmanship	Paper is neatly written or typed with no distracting corrections.	Paper is neatly written or typed with 1 or 2 distracting corrections (e.g., dark cross-outs; bumpy white-out, words written over).	The writing is generally readable, but the reader has to exert quite a bit of effort to figure out some of the words.
Creativity	The paper is creative and shows that time and effort were put into the project.	The paper is creative, but more time and effort could have been put into the project.	Little to no time was put into the paper
